'Zero Waste SA: an agent of change' with Vaughan Levitzke (Chief Executive, Zero Waste SA), plus guest speakers from Tarac Technologies and the Adelaide Convention Centre

Zero Waste SA is acknowledged nationally and internationally as a leader in waste management and resource recovery and community engagement. Since 2003, it has invested more than \$80 million for innovative, effective and well-targeted programs and projects that have stimulated councils, businesses and the community to reduce, recover, reuse and recycle. This has helped South Australia achieve a resource recovery rate of more than 77%.

Chief Executive Zero Waste SA, Vaughan Levitzke will highlight how a strategic, evidence-based approach underpinned by collaboration has seen the introduction of wide-ranging waste reforms such as: Australia's first ban on checkout-style plastic bags; Australia's most comprehensive pilot of household food scrap recycling; regional waste planning and infrastructure improvements; new recycling ventures for organics, electronic waste, construction and demolition material; industry resource efficiency; introduction of high performing kerbside collection systems; and much more!

We are fortunate to have Mark Anderson from Tarac Technologies (www.tarac.com.au) and Philip Wells from the Adelaide Convention Centre (www.adelaidecc.com.au/about-us/environmental-sustainability) who will share their own zero waste achievements. This night will be a great way to hear about the work of Zero Waste SA while also learning how other organisations are improving their operations by adopting resource efficiency practices.
