

IS Foundation Training Course



On 29 February 2012, AGIC launched the Infrastructure Sustainability (IS) rating scheme to deliver social, economic and environmental improvements across the design construction and operation of Australia's infrastructure. The **IS rating tool** is now available for use.

In order to guide and support project teams on the use of the tool, the IS Foundation Training Course has been developed. On successful completion of this course, participants will develop a good understanding of the IS rating scheme and will be able to assess projects or assets using the IS rating tool.

By attending the two day IS Foundation Training Course, participants will:

- learn how to apply IS tool to projects;
- achieve a better understanding of infrastructure sustainability;
- connect with like-minded individuals in the infrastructure industry and
- learn how to evaluate sustainability performance of projects and assets.

Participants have the opportunity to become an IS Accredited Professional subject to successful completion of an exam. The 90 minute exam is taken as part of the training course and IS Accredited Professionals will be listed on the AGIC website.

The course contents include the following topics:

- The scheme and context
- How the scheme works
- The assessment process
- The role of assessors and verifiers
- Design, As Built, Operation ratings
- Explanation of themes, categories, credits and benchmarks
- Evidence gathering and documentation
- Requirements for certification
- Reference design approach
- Materials calculator
- **Ecology calculator**

- Infrastructure investors interested in the application of ESG metrics.
