The Ebono Institute is dedicated to the creation of an independent media that corrects the current imbalance of media run and owned by major corporations.

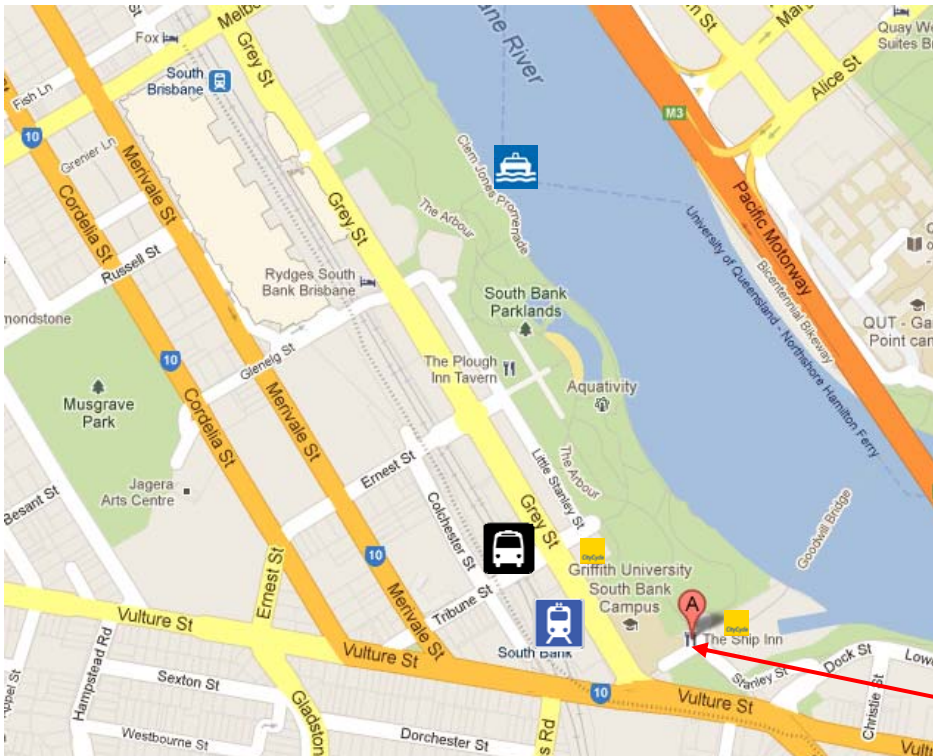
