Green Beacon runs their very own container deposit scheme with patrons able to return their "Growlers" and "Squealers" for refilling on site.

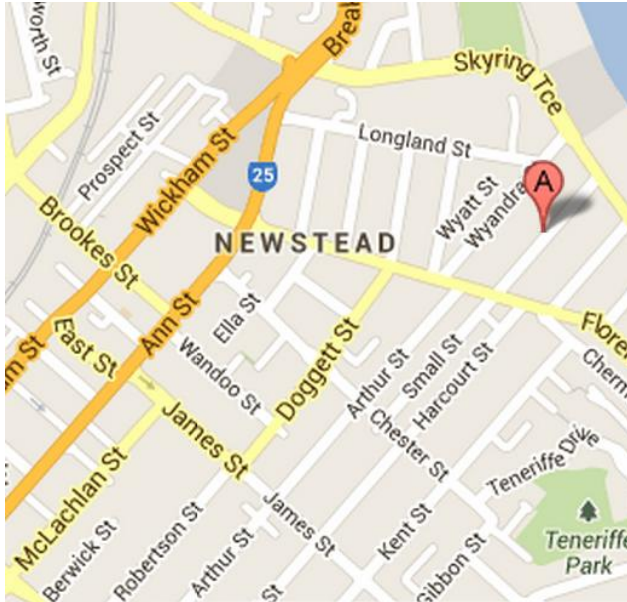

Green Beacon is located approximately 200 metres away from the river and less than a 5 minute walk away from the following transport links:

- CityCat Terminal, Teneriffe
- Bulimba Ferry stop, Teneriffe
- CityGlider
- Bus route 199 – West End to Teneriffe
- Bus route 393 – Normanby to Teneriffe
- Bus route 470 – Toowong to Teneriffe (and via Suncorp stadium)
- Night bus route N199 – West End to Teneriffe
